Product Spotlight Medeco Maxum Deadbolts



This month's product spotlight revolves around one of many deadbolts we carry. A deadbolt is a locking mechanism distinct from a spring bolt lock (lever handle) because a deadbolt **cannot** be moved to the open position except by rotating the lock cylinder. The more common spring bolt lock uses a spring

to hold the bolt in place, allowing retraction by applying force to the bolt itself. A deadbolt therefore makes a door more resistant to entry without the correct key.

Where applicable, a deadbolt is a great first line of defense when protecting your assets because deadbolts are about strength. Scope: Position requires the installation, repairing, and servicing of mechanical or electronic locking devices using both hand tools and special equipment. The employee must apply the principles and practices of the locksmith trade to a variety of locks. Resolution of problems encountered in the malfunctions of locks and hardware is an essential part of the work. Employee must be

able to make precise adjustments to parts of lock; work to close tolerances; follow detailed written or oral instruction; and modify instructions to fit the situation. In addition, the security technician must be able diagnose operational problems in locks; repair or replace worn tumblers, springs, etc.; follow specification for installation of complex systems; cut keys; re-combinate locks; and secure locks by installing holding hardware. Pay based upon experience.
